

Impact of our Curriculum -

Our students are keen to attend extra curricular clubs across a wide range of sports. We have strong numbers reflecting the positive impact that we are having through our lesson delivery. Students have the opportunity to participate in inter school competitions through inter house events, during which there is a strong emphasis on everyone to take part creating a positive contribution to our school house system. Our competitive fixtures have strong success rates across a range of sports giving students the opportunity to compete in a variety of situations. Students are given opportunities to lead across the year groups, developing their communication skills in a wide range of contexts. Our students become tactically and strategically astute and can transfer this into a multitude of contexts including competitive situations. We have an excellent uptake of students opting to take GCSE PE, further proving the positive impact our KS3 curriculum has on inspiring students to further their sporting journey with our department. We have very few students who are disengaged with our curriculum, which reflects well upon the range of engaging sports/teaching methods that we employ.

Our GCSE grades stand in the top 3% in the country further proving the impact of our curriculum design. Post GCSE level, we have a strong number of students who go on to study Physical Education at A Level, at either our campus or elsewhere. Students engage well with an enrichment programme offered to Y11 and A Level students, whereby they get to experience a range of different activities in the wider community. This is an opportunity that many students are keen to experience regardless of whether they study A Level/GCSE PE.
