Dear Parent /Carer,

All parents of students that travel on DM5 + DM2 are receiving this email. Belfitt's gave GCC notice on their contracts and are ceasing operating them on 19th July 2024 when the children finish for summer.

From September Grindles will be operating the 2 services detailed below. Your child is still allocated to the same route they are currently using, but we are transferring to using the QR Code system Grindles use.

This QR code can either be stored on your child's mobile phone or printed off so it can be scan on the tablet each time they board the bus. This QR code will replace bus passes so once your child has started using the QR code, you can destroy their bus pass. Grindles will email you the QR code by the end of August 2024.

In September if passes are still being used by students instead of their QR codes the driver will take the pass from the child, so it is out of circulation.

I have given Grindles the email address we hold for you and that is where the QR code will be sent to. I have also passed your mobile number onto them, if we have it, as they run a text system if there are any delays on the route.
