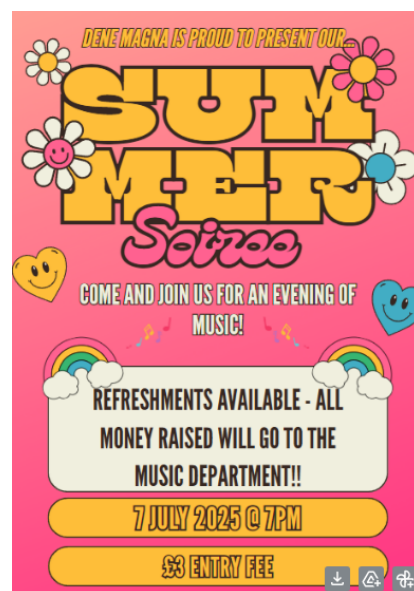

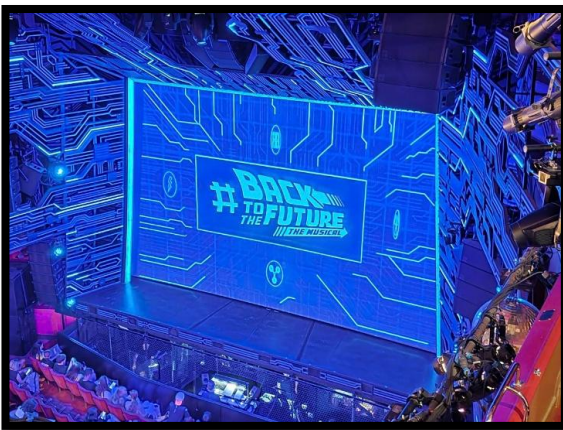
## Year 7 Normandy

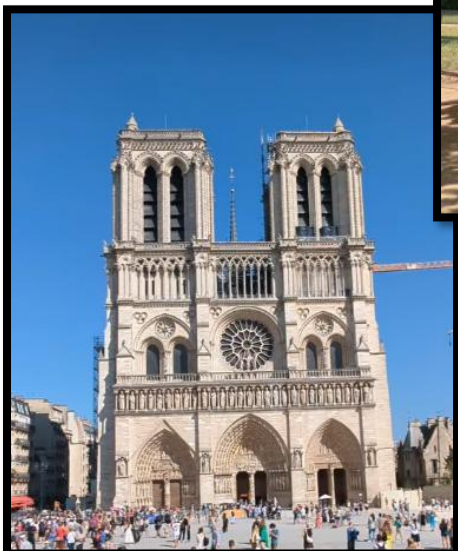
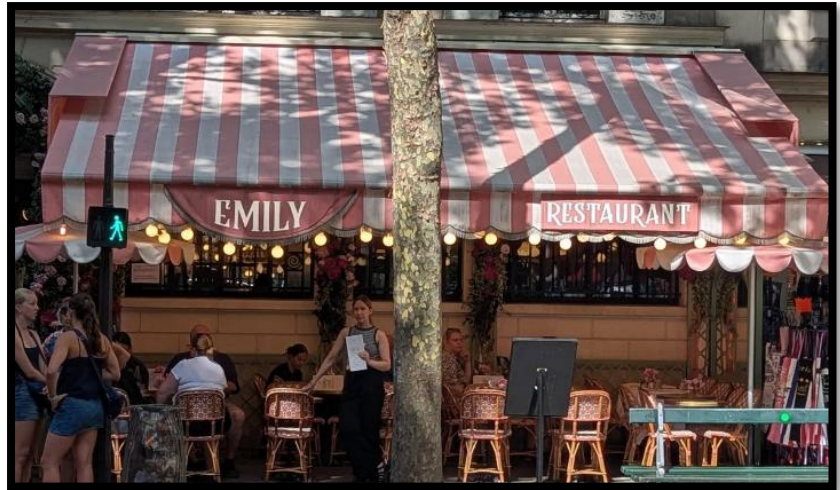
## Year 9 Camp

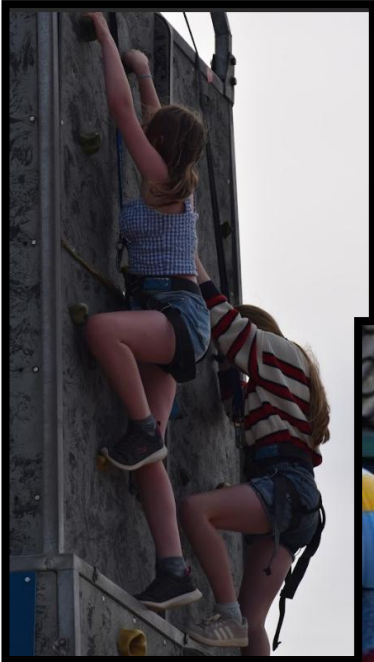


## Timetable Suspension
