Check your spelling.			
Check your punctuation. Especially capital letters and full stops.			
Write the date and underline it with a ruler.			
Underline any headings / subheadings with a ruler.			
Write out your WALT/WALTS			
Remember place names should begin with a capital letter.			
Pencil and pencil crayons should be used for diagrams.
