You will be able to see the 7 days involved a range of activities which excited and benefited students in the following subjects; Maths, English, Science, Enrichment activities, Team building, Cooking, PE, History, Geography and Drama. Over the 7 days, we had an amazing 84 students attend. We believe this was because we tailored the summer school to meet the needs of the individuals we invited and ensured the leap from Primary to Secondary education was a successful and positive change for individuals in readiness for September.



The total cost of all 84 students attending Dene Magna summer school came to £7,897. This final cost includes:

- 84 student attendance which covered the staffing costs of £7257
- £440 on equipment and resources
- £200 Enrichment activities (Rewild Project)

Total = £7,897

To conclude, the students had a thoroughly enjoyable and exciting week. They were able to meet new peers which consequently made individuals feel more confident as they entered new key stages here at Dene Magna. The opportunity of summer school has enabled students to see familiar faces around school which has positively impacted the progress they are making every day in their learning. Additionally, it has allowed us to fill any gaps in education and cover additional needs to best prepare staff and students for their first day of term.
